Tournament Addendum

If game ends in a tie there will be a 5 minute Golden Goal Period - First team to score wins

In U8 - first team to score in overtime wins - no kicks from the mark.

For U10/U12/U14/U18 if after 5 minutes the game remains tied it will be decided by (5) kicks from the mark

If the game is still tied after 5 kicks from the mark, then the teams will alternate kicks with players who did not kick in the original 5. Alternating until one team hits and one team misses.

If one team plays short, the other team must also play short.

Team forfeits if not ready to play 5 minutes after scheduled time.

Get game ball from home team (or other if needed)

U6 and U8 - All kicks are indirect free kicks. No PK's in U6 and U8.
